In this hands-on workshop, Farmer Orly will show how to grow mushrooms by inoculating a hardwood log, inserting mycelium spawn—the living network of fungal threads that will produce mushrooms—and sealing it with wax to protect it. Program fee covers all the necessary materials and registrants will go home with their own inoculated log, which can produce flushes of mushrooms for several years to come. This is a fantastic opportunity to learn a sustainable food-growing skill and enjoy the fresh, superior taste of homegrown mushrooms.
